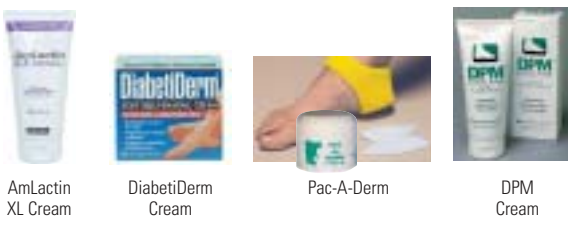

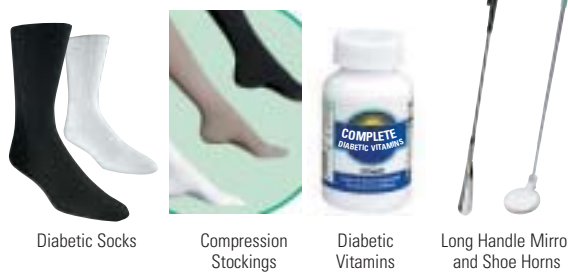

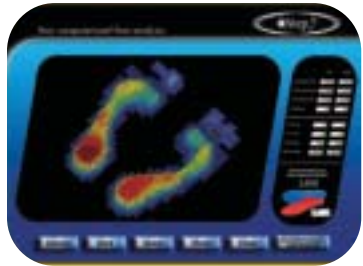
More than 25% percent of the estimated 18 million people with diabetes in the US will develop significant foot problems.

People with diabetes can develop many different foot problems. Even ordinary problems can get worse and lead to serious complications. Foot problems most often happen when there is nerve damage, also called neuropathy. Loss of feeling often means you may not feel a foot injury which could lead to foot ulcers. Diabetes can also change the skin on your feet leading to dry feet and cracked heels. If neglected, this can also lead to foot infections and loss of limb. Calluses occur more often and build up faster on the feet of people with diabetes. This is because there are high-pressure areas under the foot. If neglected this can lead to diabetic foot ulcers. Diabetes causes blood vessels of the foot and leg to narrow and harden. This can lead to poor circulation and in turn to infections and amputations. Walking in sturdy, good-fitting comfortable shoes can stimulate blood flow in the legs and feet.
